This year there will only be three offer rounds, the second being for competitive courses.

The ACU Guarantee, App FAQs and Offer FAQs pages will be updated before applications open this year. Guarantee your place at ACU, even before your Year 12 exams. The ACU Guarantee program offers eligible Year 12 students a place at ACU based on your Year 11 results.

Offers may be made as early as July. While successful applicants must still complete their Year 12 exams, you can do so secure in the knowledge that your marks from Year 11 meet our entry requirements. You may also enhance your entry score by including a short personal statement that gives ACU an insight into your personal circumstances and motivation for university study.

Key Dates:

- 1 March Applications open
- 15 May Applications close
- 22 May Document upload closes for Year 11 results, Co-Curricular activities and supporting documents for adjustment factors
- 4 Sept Offers released (September round, based on Year 11 results)
- 4 Oct Offer acceptance deadline (September round)
- 1 Nov Change of preference reopens for all programs except for Bachelor of Health Science
- 1 Nov Document upload reopens for Year 11 results, Co-Curricular activities and supporting documents for adjustment factors

Direct applications for study in 2024 are open 1 March 2023. If you apply directly for study in 2024, your application will cover admissions, scholarships and campus accommodation.

Early offers made on 4 September 2023 are based on Year 11 results. ANU will honour these for study in 2024 as long as you complete Year 12 and receive an ATAR.

If your Year 11 results don't meet entry requirements, we will put you on our waiting list and automatically consider your application again based on your Year 12 results in the December/January offer rounds.

All direct applicants are required to meet the [co-curricular or service requirement](#) as part of their application.

All direct applicants will be covered by our [accommodation guarantee](#).

For students who are interested in applying for scholarships, their eligibility is automatically assessed through our application process. There are two prestigious scholarships however that we want to call your attention to, these are the [Tuckwell](#) scholarship and the [Kambri Indigenous Undergraduate Scholarship](#).

Please be advised that applying for the **Tuckwell Scholarship** is a long process and will involve a recommendation from our school- students need to be highly organised to engage in this process!!!

For high achievers with initiative and commitment you could receive an early offer to study at Macquarie if you have performed well academically in Year 11 and demonstrate strong values and dedication through your extracurricular activities.

Eligibility

To apply for Macquarie Leaders and Achievers entry scheme, you must meet both academic and leadership criteria.

Academic requirements

Eligible applicants are:

high-achieving students who have performed well in their Year 11 studies

receiving the [New South Wales Higher School Certificate](#),

[ACT Senior Secondary Certificate](#) or

International Baccalaureate Diploma in Australia.

Leadership requirements

Applicant must demonstrate each of the following qualities through at least two of the activities (activity examples are listed further below):

Leadership: mentorship, coaching or leading a team, collaboration and teamwork skills, empathy and self-awareness.

Service and community engagement: positive benefit to others and active engagement in the school, local or wider community.

Contribution and commitment: genuine connection with your chosen purpose, persistence and dedication to manage self and/or work with others to achieve a goal.

Initiative: independent thought and action; ability to anticipate needs.

Self-efficacy: self-awareness, personal learning and development.

SCU Early Offer

Applications open 4 April 2023

Current Year 12 students can receive an Early Offer. The Early Offer program allows Year 12 students to secure a place in a Southern Cross University degree before Year 12 results are released. It's designed to remove some of the pressure from Year 12 and provide a pathway directly into university study that is not based solely on Year 12 results.

Why should I apply for Early Offer?

This program allows you to gain an offer into a Southern Cross University course of your choice, * based on your high school grades and your school principal's recommendation.

Who is eligible?

Any student completing Year 12 studies at an Australian school in 2023 can apply.

How to apply. Here is how it works:

Create an application nominating your degree and campus of choice.

Your application must be completed in the one browser session.

SRS Applications closing TBA in early April 2023

If you're a current Year 12 student applying to UC for undergraduate study next year, you could receive an alternative early admission offer under the Schools Recommendation Scheme (SRS) using criteria other than your ATAR.

If you're a current Year 12 student, your school can recommend you for admission to the University of Canberra in advance of receiving your ATAR results, based on your abilities and success to date. Like your main application to UC, Schools Recommendation Scheme applications are also made through [UAC](#).

If you apply for the SRS, your school's rating of your aptitudes will be considered, including your capacity

for tertiary study. Applying through the SRS doesn't guarantee you an offer to the University of Canberra, as course quotas and other criteria still need to be considered.

UNSW Gateway Winter Program

If you're in Year 12, the Gateway Admission Pathway is an alternative pathway to UNSW which considers more than just your ATAR. It offers early entry to UNSW or a significantly lower ATAR entry requirement for a range of degrees.

To be eligible for the Gateway Admission Pathway, you must:

- be an Australian resident
- be completing an Australian Year 12 qualification in the year of application
- attend a Gateway school or live in a low-socioeconomic area based on IRSAD and IEO indexes of [SEIFA criteria](#).

You do not need to apply for MySydney.

The University will contact you directly if you are eligible for MySydney.

To be eligible, you must be:

a domestic student residing in an area listed in the bottom 25 percent according to Australian Bureau of Statistics Socio-Economic Index for Areas (SEIFA) Index of Education and Occupation (IEO) data based on the residential address you enter in your UAC undergraduate application*

applying as a new University of Sydney student for an undergraduate degree in Semester 1 or 2.

High school students and non-recent school leavers will both be eligible under the scheme.

If you're eligible, place your chosen MySydney course as your highest eligible UAC preference. If you meet the MySydney ATAR, and other admission requirements, you will be made an unconditional offer to study and receive the MySydney Scholarship.

*If you receive a notification from UAC notifying you that the residential address you entered in your UAC undergraduate application is identified by the Australian Bureau of Statistics as being in the lowest 25% of socio-economic disadvantage, this does not mean you meet the eligibility for MySydney. You must receive confirmation of your eligibility directly from the University of Sydney.

No additional adjustment factors from any other scheme may be applied to the MySydney ATAR.

Please note: courses may become full after the UAC December Round 2.
